UPDATE ON NZTR COVID-19 DIRECTIVES – ALERT LEVEL 1

With all regions in New Zealand at Alert Level 1, the required raceday protocols are amended and the attached directive 'NZTR Directive COVID-19 Alert Level 1 (13 October 2020)' prevails until further notice.

The differences, between the attached and a meeting held in a 'Level 1' region under the Alert Levels 1 and 2 Directive are:

Temperature screening for jockeys and people working around the weigh-room is no longer required

The encouragement of mask wearing in the defined areas is removed

Otherwise, things are unchanged:

Availability of hand sanitizer

Regular disinfectant of surfaces

Personal Responsibilities regards health status (e.g. don't come if feeling symptoms)

Other general health and physical distancing provisions

Prominent display of govt COVID QR codes
